

## Transportation between Mexico City Airport and Puebla

The buses from the Mexico City airport to Puebla are luxury coaches (see photos of buses and ticket counters at Terminal 1 and 2 below). *(Note that these buses are public transportation and not specific to IAIA11 participants.)* They depart from the airport terminals about every 30 to 60 minutes. The departure schedule is available at <http://www.estrellaroja.com.mx>.

Purchase your bus ticket just inside the door where the buses are parked. Purchase a ticket for the bus that takes you directly to 4 Poniente (abbreviated 4 Pte) in Puebla, which means 4th Street West. That way, after leaving Mexico City, the bus will stop only at the bus station in Puebla. The fare is about \$17 US each way; snacks and a beverage are provided. Be sure to note that the ticket is stamped with a departure time.

Buses generally make the trip in two hours, except during weekday heavy traffic periods (7:00 – 9:00 pm) when it will take longer.

There is a taxi stand inside the bus station in Puebla. You pay for your cab fare to your hotel at the taxi stand – not to the taxi driver. Depending on the distance, the trip may cost between \$4 and \$8 USD. You may tip your driver when you reach your hotel.
