Support for Professionals from Developing Countries or Countries in Transition

Major Event | Target Date | 5 December 2003

At approximately Cdn \$10,000 per person, your organization could select the number of persons to sponsor. The sponsorship covers conference registration, pre-meeting training course, special activities, airfare, hotel, and daily expenses. The amount will vary depending upon the home country of each of the participants. Because of the time needed to make travel and visa arrangements, this sponsorship must be confirmed by 15 December 2003.
