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# SEA Directive 2001/42/EC

Sweden - legally transposed

2004, 21 July Environmental Code (procedure)

2005, 1 July Environmental Ordinance (which plans and programmes)

Programme of measure – Environmental quality norms, air and water

Screening:

#### The European Landscape Convention

Council of Europe

#### **Definition:**

"Landscape" means an area, as perceived by people, whose character is the result of the action and interaction of natural and/or human factors



## ELC ...

"Landscape quality objective" means, for a specific landscape, the formulation by the competent public authorities of the aspirations of the public with regard to the landscape features of their surroundings
