◆Types of Sponsorship

We welcome your sponsorship of IAIA'03. We have included cost estimates to assist in your planning. Confirmation of your sponsorship by the target date of 15 April 2003 (unless otherwise noted) ensures you will receive the benefits promised and increases the chance that your choice is still available. If the target date has passed and you are still interested in contributing, please contact IAIA Headquarters to see what opportunities remain available.

The following are suggestions for several IAIA'03 sponsorship opportunities, including four major conference events and numerous other items. Please note that any sponsorship which affects the conference program must be approved by the IAIA'03 Program Committee.

◆ Special Interest Stream/Workshop

Major Event | Target Date 15 October 2002/15 April 2003

Your organization may sponsor a stream of papers, workshops or presentations in an area of special interest to you. IAIA will promote your area of interest, solicit experts to organize and deliver this part of the program, edit the resulting papers and presentations, and print a limited number for distribution. Cost will range between \$50,000 and \$75,000 depending on the extent of your activities. As this event requires significant organization and planning, sponsorship commitment is required by 15 October 2002 for announcement in the preliminary program or 15 April 2003 for inclusion in the final program.

◆ Conference Awards Ceremony

Major Event | Target Date 15 April 2003

IAIA's annual awards ceremony includes an elaborate luncheon or dinner, depending on the conference schedule. The awards ceremony, venue, program, and meal range in cost between \$25,000 and \$40,000.

Support for Professionals from Developing Countries/Economies in Transition

Major Event | Target Date 1 February 2003

At approximately \$6,000 per person, your organization could select the number of persons to sponsor. The sponsorship covers conference registration, pre-meeting training course, special activities, airfare, hotel, and daily expenses. The amount will vary depending upon the home country of each of the participants. Because of the time needed to make travel and visa arrangements, this sponsorship must be confirmed by 1 February 2003.

♦ Conference Lunches

Major Event | Target Date 15 April 2003

Four lunches are provided to delegates throughout the conference, each costing approximately \$10,000. Sponsorship could include one or more lunches.

◆ Computer Projectors

Target Date 15 October 2002/15 April 2003

Computer projectors, beamers, LCD or PowerPoint projectors: whatever term you use, IAIA conference delegates are demanding this presentation technology. However, equipment rental fees make it cost-prohibitive for IAIA events. Sponsoring this item would allow speakers in paper sessions, training courses, and plenaries to present their information in the most effective, efficient, and environmentally friendly way. Approximately \$15,000.
