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

 - Two most typical EIA-projects included


The input-output model of policy instruments Examples of criteria for evaluation Based on Hildén et al. 2002,




Framework for the Influence of EIA on Formulation of Project and Decision-Making


	Effects on the project alternatives	Effects on the decision- making process		
Prior to EIA	A. Consideration of the environmental impacts e.g. assessment of local features, former conditions and definition of the project	B. Consciousness of environmental legislation obligations e.g. timeout in decision-making, presentation of decision-making, other parallel processes		
During EIA	C. Practical advancement of the project e.g. recognition and valuation of environmental impacts	D. Adaptation of environmental legislation principles e.g. consideration of environmental issues, make public participation and public debate possible		
After EIA	E. Adaptation of the project to local level e.g. prevention or mitigation of environmental impacts	F. Realisation of environmental policy e.g. supporting decision-making, acceptability

Conclusions

- The influence of EIA is <u>not</u> a one-time impact
- EIA affects all along the decision-making process
- * Anticipation, comparison, justification
- ★ The most essential impact is the <u>direct</u> influence on the formulation of the project (i.e. the preparation of the decision-making) → <u>indirect</u> influence on the formal decision-making
- Dependence on the context and the planning history of the project Teedback"
